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

Information for parents about the transition to secondary schools for children with special educational needs





Dear parents, Dear legal guardians

After the summer holidays, your child will attend fourth grade and receive a special educational support there.

In the fall, you will have to make a decision about school choice. Therefore you will be invited to a **consultation** about your child's future school career at your **local primary school**.

As part of this consultation, you will sign a form on which your request will be noted.

The current **class leader** knows your child well and will **support** you in making the right decision.

With this flyer we would like to provide you with important information so that you can clarify any questions you may have.

Your right to vote

If your child continues to need special educational support after the 4th grade, you legally have the choice between **two possible support locations** for your child (see § 16 AO-SF):

Attending a general school

(Primary school, secondary school, upper secondary school, comprehensive school and possibly high school)

Your child will learn alongside children who do not require special educational support.

Inclusive schooling means that your child continues to receive special educational support. General school teachers as well as special education teachers and, if necessary, other specialist staff are available for this purpose

Attending a special school

Your child will usually learn in smaller groups with children who need similar special educational support.

For this purpose, only special education teachers and additional specialist staff work with your child at special schools.
